- · Only those with passes will be permitted in the warm-up area



Best lifter trophies to Youth/Junior, Open and Masters Based on Wilks formula and Wilks² for Masters across ages. There will also be team trophies for Nations.

Presentation is not included in entry, but confirmation of numbers is required for bookings. Please advise by final nomination date banquet numbers






ATTRACTIONS












LOCATIONS
